

ORDER SND/399/2020, 9TH OF MAY, FOR THE FLEXIBILIZATION OF CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS OF NATIONAL SCOPE ESTABLISHED DURING THE DECLARATION OF STATE OF ALARM, IN APPLICATION OF PHASE 1 REGARDING THE PLAN FOR THE TRANSITION TO A NEW NORMALITY.

The Order SND/399/2020 regulates the measures to be applied from 11th of May in some of the territories nationwide that have moved onto Phase 1 -in addition to the islands of Formentera, La Gomera, Hierro and La Graciosa, which were already in Phase 1 since the 4th of May-, which are: Galicia, Asturias, Cantabria, Basque Country, La Rioja, Navarra, Aragon, Extremadura, Murcia, Baleares, Canarias, Ceuta and Melilla, and some of the provinces and/or areas of Andalucía, Catalonia, Valencian Community, Castilla La Mancha and Castilla y León.

Although the flexibilization measures established for Phase 1 were redacted in Order SND/386/2020, which can be found summarized in the following [link](#), the present Order derogates the latter whilst it contains the measures included in said Order SND/386/2020 and introduces new ones, the following being the **most significant**:

- **Within the Laboral scope:**
 - Encouraging "work from home" for those who can carry out their activity remotely.
 - Employer must make available for employees hydroalcoholic gels and guarantee social distancing among personnel or, if that's not possible, facilitate individual protection equipment.
 - Employer must make schedule adjustments in order to avoid risks arising from masses of people.
 - Cleaning and disinfecting measures are mandatory and shall be adapted to the characteristics and uses of each center, establishments and premises.

- **Measures of a social and personal characteristic:**
 - Freedom of movement within the same province, island or territorial unit used to determine their de-escalation process; however, the freedom of movement to other parts of the national territory remains forbidden.
 - In worship premises, the use of masks is mandatory.
 - In worship premises, cleaning and disinfecting activities of the premises shall be carried out before every meeting or mass.

- **Retail establishments and commercial premises and assimilated services:**
 - Automotive dealers, TIV (ITV, in Spanish) stations, garden centers and plant nurseries will be able to reopen to the public by means of appointment.

- **Regarding services and benefits in the field of Social Services:**
 - The premises where social services are issued shall be open and available for essential face-to-face service, with the adoption of prevention and hygiene measures. Whenever possible, telematic service will be a priority.

- **Reopening of educational centers and universities:**
 - It is allowed to reopen educational centers and universities in order to accommodate them, disinfect them and for the carrying out of administrative tasks, ensuring social distancing among employees.
 - The distribution of spaces and circulation of people shall be modified in order to guarantee the interpersonal safety distance.
 - The use of documents in paper will be limited.
 - Regarding universities, laboratories may open in order to carry out their investigation activities, given that interpersonal safety distance is guaranteed and personnel is given protection equipment.
- **Flexibilization measures in the field of science and innovation:**
 - Public and private entities that develop or assist activities within scientific and technical investigation, and development and innovation in an economic or social area, may restart their activity and that of their its premises.
 - All premises used shall be cleaned and disinfected periodically.
 - Events, congresses and seminars within the area of scientific and technical investigation and innovation are allowed, given that interpersonal safety distance among assistants is guaranteed. However, the maximum number of assistants is 30.
- **Reopening of libraries and museums:**
 - Public and private libraries are allowed to reopen for the following activities: book loans and returning of books, reading, and bibliographic and library information. Cultural activities, group studying and interlibrary loans are forbidden.
 - Loaned or consulted books shall be set aside for a quarantine of, at least, 14 days.
 - Museums may reopen to allow individual visits -the visit or a person or a family or house unit-, reducing their capacity to a third. Cultural or didactic activities are forbidden.
- **Production development and filming of audiovisual works:**
 - Certain activities associated to the production and filming are allowed, such as wardrobe, makeup and sound.
 - Filming in public and private spaces is allowed, given that it has been granted authorization by the City Council.
- **Public reopening of premises where cultural shows take place:**
 - They are allowed to open, given that the capacity is reduced to a third. If they are to take place in closed spaces, there cannot be more that 30 people; if they take place in open spaces, the capacity shall not exceed 200 people.
 - Viewers will have to be seated and keeping safety distance with each other. Moreover, it is recommended that shows do not have intermissions.
- **Development of professional and federated sport activities:**

- Access to High Performance Centers is granted to athletes integrated in approved programs, High Performance athletes and athletes of sports recognized as national interest by the Sports High Council.
 - Sports clubs can carry out medium trainings that consist in individual tasks and tactical training in groups smaller than 10 athletes.
 - Technical meetings are allowed with a maximum of 10 people, keeping interpersonal safety distance.
 - Medical control shall be carried out for personnel.
 - Open-spaced sport premises are allowed to open for individual practice. The allowed capacity of such premises will be of 30%.
 - The provisions in this chapter are not applied to sport hunting and fishing.
- **Public reopening of hotels and touristic premises:**
 - Hotels' restaurants and cafeterias shall follow the general rules for hospitality premises. However, for hotel clients, hotels are allowed to provide such services, given that they aren't carried out in common areas.
 - Pools, spas, gymnasiums, children's areas, event halls and similar spaces are not allowed to be used.
 - Hotels and touristic premises will have to inform clients about all restrictive measures in all of the most habitual languages spoken by clients.
